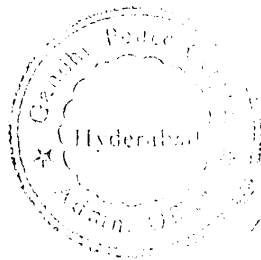

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION  
OF THE  
GANDHI PEACE CENTRE, TIRUPATI  
- - - - -

1. The name of the institution shall be 'Gandhi Peace Centre' herein after called 'CENTRE'.
2. The Registered Office of the institution is located at Shantinagar, K. T. Road, TIRUPATI 517 501(A.P).
3. The Centre is a charitable institution formed with the following aims and objects:
  - a) to undertake study and research and constructive activities aimed at relieving the population generally and rural population particularly from their existing poverty, economic depression and ignorance;
  - b) to develop backward villages and weaker sections of people through integrated socio-economic activities in agriculture, horticulture, irrigation, non-formal education, adult education, youth training, women and child welfare activities and improve the living conditions of the villagers;
  - c) to inculcate and propagate study and practice of Gandhian values i.e., Truth and Non-violence (Satya and Ahimsa) thought and action, maintain peaceful, harmonious, happy social relations without hatred or violence;
  - d) to establish and maintain mutual cooperation and understanding among other persons and institutions with similar objects;
  - e) to set up training centres, assist in research, planning and evaluation of programmes;



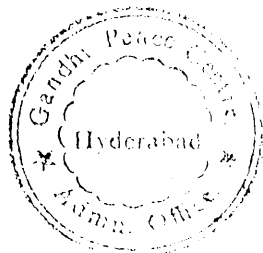

- f) to establish libraries and to do such other acts as may be conducive to the attainment of the above objects and to promote the establishment of libraries and reading rooms;
- g) to acquire movable, and immovable properties on behalf of the Centre, to utilise, sell and mortgage etc., or otherwise deal with the movable and immovable properties of the Centre;
- h) to fulfill the above objects of the Centre, the Centre shall raise funds and contribution, and can spend, sell, mortgage or collect movable and immovable properties wherever necessary, establish offices, open branches and works so on to improve the position of the Centre;
- i) to raise funds for the proper functioning of the Centre from member either as donation, deposit, advance loan, subscription or otherwise and also receive from public institutions, Government agencies (Statutory Boards) such as other boards funds by way of loan, grant and subsidy etc.,
- j) to produce necessary and useful literature for propagating the objects of the Centre in order to develop the knowledge of this programme;

4. The names, addresses, occupations and designations of the present members of the Managing Committee to whom the management of affairs of the Centre are entrusted as required under Section 2 of the Societies Registration

RULES AND REGULATIONS  
OF THE  
GANDHI PEACE CENTRE, TIRUPATI  
- - - - -

I. Name of the Association:

The name of the Association shall be 'GANDHI PEACE CENTRE', herein after called 'CENTRE'.

II. Situation of the Registered Office:

The Registered Office of the Gandhi Peace Centre shall be situated at Shantinagar, K. T. Road, TIRUPATI 517 501 (A.P), or in any place as decided by the Governing Body by informing to the concerning authorities.

III. Aims and objectives:

The aims and objectives of this Centre are those set out fully in the Memorandum of Association.

IV. RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. The Area of Operation:

The Centre may have activities extended in ~~all the~~ <sup>The States of Andhra Pradesh</sup> ~~States and territories of the Indian Union.~~

2. Membership: The Membership shall be of the following categories namely:

(a) INDIVIDUAL (b) INSTITUTIONAL (c) HONORARY.

(a) Individual Members: All persons above the age of 21 years recognised by the Centre as bonafide members and not engaged in any activity inconsistant with the aims and objects of the Centre, may, on application,

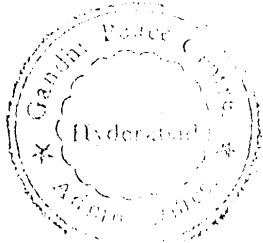
be enrolled as members on payment of Rs.100/00 towards membership fee. The individual members are life members who are the founder members of the Centre.

(b) Institutional Members: All institutional members who are engaged in Gandhian and constructive activities may be admitted as institutional members on payment of Rs.100/00 as membership fee per annum.

(c) Honorary Members: Only such individuals, as in the opinion of the Governing Body of the Centre have been found qualified because of their distinguished services in the furtherance of the aims and objects, or such outstanding personalities whose membership in the opinion of the Governing Body shall add to the general prestige of the Centre, be invited by a 'situation' and a special resolution of the Governing Body to join the Centre as an Honorary Member. Honorary members will not enjoy all privileges available to individual members. They will act only as advisers to the Centre.

Cessation of Membership: The membership of any category shall be liable for termination by a simple majority vote and on report of the Governing Body that

- (a) the behaviour of the members has been prejudicial or detrimental to the principles and objects of the Centre;
- (b) if the member
  - i) proved to be below of 21 years of age;
  - ii) has been found to be of unsound mind;
  - iii) has been convicted of a criminal charge involving moral turpitude;
  - iv) is an undischarged insolvent.

3. CENTRE: All life members shall form into a 'Centre' hereinafter known as 'GANDHI PEACE CENTRE'.

4. GENERAL BODY: All members refer to in the above Clause No. (3) shall constitute the General Body of the Centre and shall meet atleast once in a year during the month of June 2017

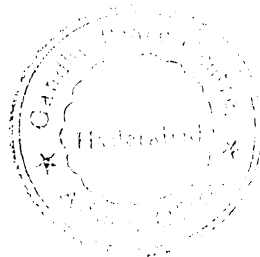
i) consider and pass the annual report with the audited accounts and statements which shall relate to the period from 1st April to 31st March of calender year;

ii) consider and pass the budget for the ensuing year;

iii) appoint an auditor for the ensuing year and to fix his remuneration for the same;

iv) to elect the Office bearers and members of the Governing Body.

5. EXTRAORDINARY MEETING: The Chairman may convene an extraordinary meeting of the Governing Body on the written requisition of not less than one-fourth of the members of the Governing Body or on the basis of a special resolution of the Governing Body. Every requisition so made by the members shall express the object for which the meeting is proposed to be called and shall be left at the address of the Centre. Upon receiving any such requisition, the Chairman shall forthwith convene a meeting of the Governing Body. At all extraordinary meetings no subject other than stated in the notice or the requisition, as the case may be shall be discussed except with the permission of the Chairman.



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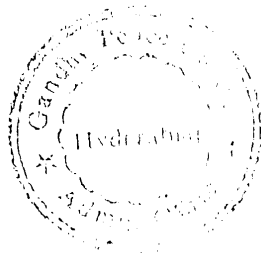

6. FUNCTIONS OF THE GOVERNING BODY:

- a) to exercise general control over the affairs of the Centre and give guidance to it;
- b) to pass the annual report and audited accounts of the Centre for publication;
- c) to pass the annual budget of the Centre;
- d) to frame rules and bye-laws for the Centre;
- e) to present the Centre in its correspondence with the Government or any Public Body;
- f) to take necessary legal steps or direct the taking of such steps in the interest of the Centre;
- g) generally to do all work relating to the affairs of the Centre not otherwise provided for;
- h) to adopt such other measures as would promote the above mentioned or similar objects for which the Centre is founded.

7. MANAGEMENT OF THE CENTRE:

- a) The management of the Centre shall be vested with seven founder members who shall serve for life. The seven founder members shall nominate five members from outside to form the Governing Body;
- b) The Office bearers of the Centre shall be from among the founder members themselves and their term shall be five years;
- c) If the place of the founder members falls vacant due to resignation, insane or death that place shall be filled in by the remaining founder members unanimously.

- d) The entire property (NIDHI) of the Centre shall vest with the Governing Body.

8. OFFICE BEARERS:

The Governing Body shall have seven members with the following Office bearers:

- i) Chairman.
  - ii) Secretary.
  - iii) Members - 5.
- b) Shri Radhakrishna shall work as the Chairman of the Centre, and Shri Veeraiiah shall work as the Secretary. The Office bearers will work for a period of five years. Subsequent election of Office bearers will be done by the founder members of the Governing Body.
- c) The Governing Body shall be empowered to appoint Sub-Committee and Research Advisory Committees for specific purposes of activities of the Centre.

9. FUNDS OF THE CENTRE:

- a) Donation and contribution from other sources;
- b) Grants made by the Central and State Governments;
- c) Income from investments;
- d) The funds shall be spent only for the attainment of the objects of the Centre only and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of its members through any means.

10. MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY:

- a) The Governing Body shall meet as and when necessary but shall meet atleast twice a year. Every meeting of the Governing Body shall be presided over by the Chairman. In his absence the members shall choose one amongst them present to preside over the meeting;
- b) All questions at any meetings of the Centre shall be determined as far as possible unanimously or by a majority of votes. Every member of the Governing Body shall have one vote. In case of an equality of votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote in addition to his ordinary vote.

11. Q U O R U M:

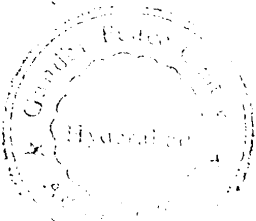
- a) the quorum for the 'General Body' shall be 2/3rd of its total members;
- b) the quorum for the 'Governing Body' shall be FOUR.

12. MEETINGS:

Every notice calling a meeting of the Governing Body shall indicate the date, time and place at which such meeting will be held and shall be served upon every member not less than fourteen days before the day appointed for such meeting.

13. DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS:

- a) Duties of the Chairman:
  - i) to preside over the meeting of the Governing Body and General Body;
  - ii) to raise the necessary finances and exercise full control and supervision over finances and administration of the Centre;

- iii) to supervise the activities of the Centre;
- iv) to appoint, dismiss or suspend staff members of the Centre on the recommendation of the Secretary.

b) Duties of the Secretary:

The Secretary shall have full authority to carry on the general day to day administration of the Centre. He shall

- i) carry out all the policies, plans and the programmes of work initiated, laid down or approved by the Governing Body;
- ii) control, direct and supervise all activities and do all acts that are necessary for effective implementation of the programmes of work of the Centre;
- iii) deal with cash, accounts, records and documents of the Centre;
- iv) carry on correspondance for and on behalf of the Centre;
- v) generally do all such things as the Governing Body may decide from time to time;
- vi) convene the meetings of the Governing Body and General Body as per the advice of the Chairman.

c) Duties of the Members:

All the members shall assist to the Chairman, and Secretary of the Centre in day to day work.

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14. CONSTITUTION OF THE SUB-COMMITTEES:

The Governing Body may by resolution appoint:

- a) sub-committee for such purposes and with such powers as the Governing Body may think fit;
- b) Advisory Board consisting of persons who need not be members of the Centre with such Advisory functions as the Governing Body may think proper.

15. BYE-LAWS:

The Governing Body shall have powers to make such bye-laws as they deem fit for regulation of the business of the Centre and in particular with reference to the preparation and sanction of the Budget estimates, the sanctioning of expenditure, entering into contracts and investments of the Centre.

16. AMENDMENTS OR ALTERATIONS ETC:

No amendment or alteration shall be made in the purpose of the Centre unless it is voted by 2/3rd of the members present at a meeting specifically convened for the purpose and confirmed by 2/3rd of the members present at a second special meeting as provided in the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860.

17. BUSINESS BY CIRCULARS:

Any business which it may be necessary for the Governing Body to transact (except such as may be placed before its annual meeting) may be transacted by circulation among all its members and any resolution so circulated and approved by a majority of the members signing the

circular shall be as effective and binding as if such resolution had been passed at a meeting of the Governing Body.

Provided that, however, atleast five members consisting of three Office bearers and two Committee members have recorded their view on the resolution.

18. BANKERS AND ACCOUNTS:

- a) The Bankers of the Centre shall be decided by the Governing Body. All funds shall be paid into the Centre's account with the said Bank and shall not be withdrawn except by means of a Cheque signed by Secretary and / or by another Officer of the Centre as may be duly empowered in this behalf by the Governing Body;
- b) The accounts of the Centre shall be audited by a qualified Auditor or Auditors appointed by the General Body, the nature of audit to be applied and the detailed arrangements to be made in regard to the form of accounts and their maintenance and the presentation of the accounts shall be decided by the Governing Body in consultation with the Auditors.

19. OFFICIAL YEAR:

The financial year of the Centre shall be from APRIL to MARCH.

20. ACCEPTANCE OF DONATIONS ETC:

The Governing Body may accept the management of any endowment fund trust fund or subscription or donations.

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21. DELEGATION OF POWERS TO THE CHAIRMAN AND SECRETARY:

The Governing Body may by resolution to the Chairman and or the Secretary such of its powers for the conduct of business as it may think fit.

22. WINDING UP:

In case the Centre decides to wind up its activities, then the properties and funds of the Centre, that will remain after full satisfaction of the liabilities of the Centre, will be transferred or paid to some other institutions or institution with similar aims and objects only. They will be determined by the votes of 3/5th of the members of the Centre present personally or by proxy at the time of the dissolution of the Centre.

The detailed instructions on the subject contained in the relevant sections of the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 will be scrupulously followed:

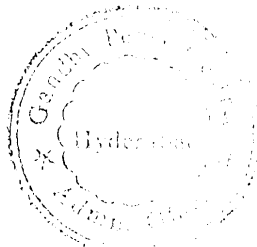
